End of Life Care Working Group (EOLWG) Patient Care Passport: Clinical Lead

A need has been identified to improve the collection, availability, and reliability of clinical information associated with patients approaching the end of life, irrespective of diagnosis, particularly at the interfaces between community and hospital care. Working in close collaboration with a wide range of clinicians, agencies and patient representatives committed to improving Patient Care, the College has been tasked with the responsibility of facilitating this collaborative and inclusive process.

This project is intended to run over a two year period, but a review of progress at the end of the first year will determine the second year funding.

Essential Criteria:

- A General Practitioner, in good standing with the GMC
- Involvement in active practice (including regular locum work), for a minimum of three years
- Experienced, and confident in the use of the common GP computer systems
- Able to work in an inclusive and collaborative manner, while at the same time keep to designated time frames
- Keen interest in improving the delivery of end of life care, and clinical experience of delivering such care in a multi-professional environment
- Driving license and access to own vehicle

Desirable Criteria:

- Experience of conducting research projects
- Experience of delivering innovation in the clinical setting within a fixed time-frame

Duties and Responsibilities of the Clinical Lead:

- To systematically lead the development and delivery of the RCGP NI Patient Care Passport programme
- Responsibility for the day to day progressing of this programme and meeting the agreed targets set by the EOLWG
- Responsibility for regularly updating the EOLWG and, through the College, regularly disseminating information about the process across the region
- Responsible to the Chair of the RCGP NI - In addition he/she will be responsible to the EOLWG and its Chair

- Administrative support will be provided by the Membership and Events Administrator at RCGP NI
- Project support will be provided by the RCGP Northern Ireland End Of Life Care Working Group
