Over 50 per cent of sight loss is due to preventable or treatable causes, namely, age-related macular degeneration (AMD), glaucoma and diabetic retinopathy. Eye problems account for 1.5% of GP consultations in the UK with a rate of 50 consultations per 1000 population per year (RCGP Curriculum Statement 15.5).

This course aims to cover some of the common eye related problems seen regularly by GPs and is designed to expand upon the knowledge and skill of current GP eye care by providing a practical, thorough and time efficient approach to the eye patient that the primary healthcare professional can immediately put into practice.
