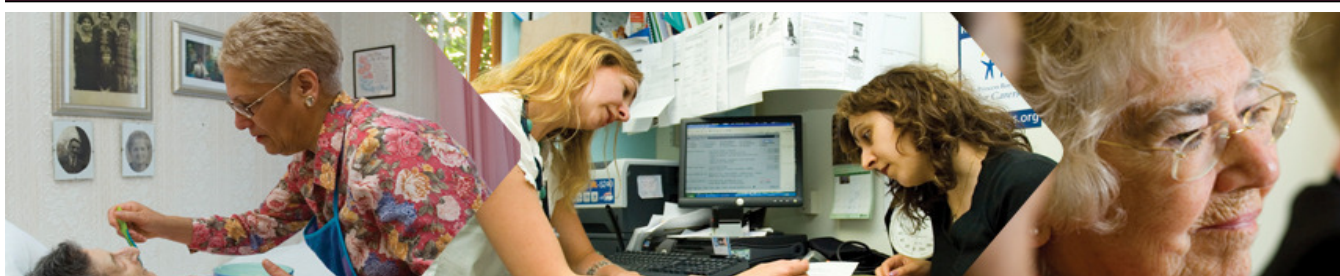

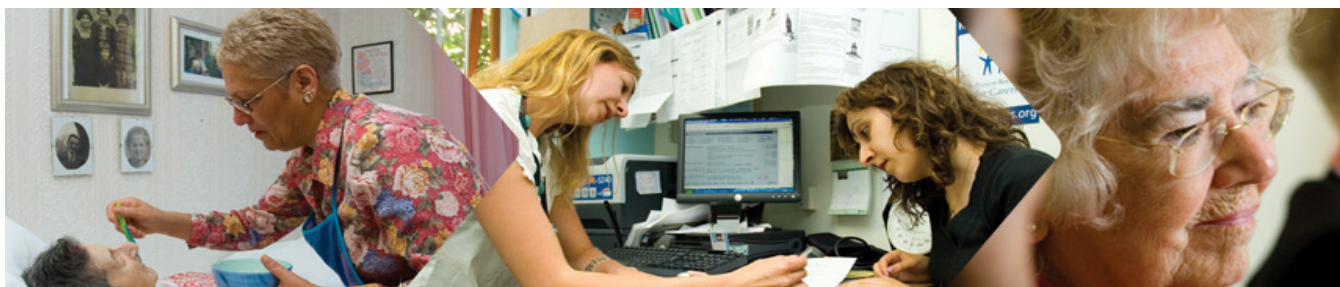

An increasing number of people are taking on the role of carers due to an ageing population and other changes in society. Carers often need to balance these responsibilities with work and other commitments and currently suffer from a lack of support which often results in illness.

Their first point of contact with the NHS is usually a GP and it is becoming increasingly important that GPs and the primary team understand the needs of carers and are able to offer them appropriate support and work in partnership with them.
