We are accepting submissions in the following categories:

Paper

15-minute (including Q&A) presentation of your paper, research, audit or problem-solving exercise

Poster

To be displayed in the exhibition area throughout the conference

Film/other media

To be screened and/or presented at the conference

You can make as many submissions as you wish but please indicate clearly on the form below which category your submission is intended for.

Your submission will be peer reviewed by a panel made up of the conference Chair and experts in the field. Feedback on submissions will be available.
