Academic training	When a trainee has split their time between academic and clinical placements and has been awarded an academic outcome 1	"The Panel has assessed clinical and academic progress during the review period and can confirm satisfactory progression"
	When a trainee has split their time between academic and clinical placements and has been awarded an academic outcome 6	"The Panel has assessed clinical and academic competences and can confirm that the trainee has met all required capabilities for the completion of training"
Panel Chair	When an alternative Panel Chair who is not listed as a panel member has signed the ARCP form	"Although the signatory of the final ARCP was not listed as in attendance at the panel, Dr has reviewed the evidence and are in agreement with the Panel view and outcome."

Short posts	When a training post to be assessed is less than two months in duration	'The panel has reviewed the short post (specialty/dates) and can confirm that there is/there is not sufficient evidence of learning for it to count towards training"
Shortened extensions	When a trainee meets the competences of the programme in less extension time than awarded by an ARCP Panel	'The Panel can confirm that all competences outstanding at the ARCP panel dated have been met in less time than recommended at the panel.'
Unassessed training	When a previous ARCP Panel did not assess a period of training	"The Panel has reviewed the period of training between xx/xx/xxxx – xx/xx/xxxx and can confirm (outcome)"
Inter-Deanery transfers (IDTs)	When a trainee is due to transfer to another deanery/HEE office	"Dr is due to transfer to (new deanery location) on xx/xx/xxxx"
Programme length	When a training programme is longer than requirements due to rotation arrangements or an administrative reason (i.e. not due to absence or an outcome 3 extension)	"Due to (reason), Dr has completed more training time than required"
Targeted GP Trainees	When a TGPT trainee is deemed ready to sit the outstanding exam/s	"The ARCP panel has carefully considered all the available evidence and can/cannot confirm that, from the evidence provided by the trainee, they are ready to sit the xxx exam"
