Treatment **A prescription to treat the crisis in general practice**

- The Department of Health must ensure that it allocates at least **11%** of its budget to meet the needs of general practice
- We urge all political parties in Northern Ireland to commit to rolling out the Multidisciplinary team model across Northern Ireland at pace, to ensure all patients have equal access to the enhanced service that this provides
- All political representatives must commit to taking action to tackle the unsustainable workload in general practice
- It is essential that political leaders commit to increasing training places and expanding the GP workforce
- All political parties must act to ensure GPs have dedicated time and resource to train medical students, as the future generation of doctors across all medical specialities
- Ensuring physical premises and digital infrastructure in general practice are fit for purpose for patients and staff must be a key priority for the next Assembly mandate.
